Robert Finch believed in the power of education and held a Bachelor of Science degree from Morgan State University and a Master's degree from Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), both in Social Work.

Robert served his military tour of duty in Frankfurt, Germany and worked first in the Virgin Islands for the Department of Health, Division of Mental Health and then as Director of the Drug and Alcohol Division for the Veteran's Administration, in Washington, DC. Scholarship Description

The Virgin Islands Association, DC Robert Finch Memorial Scholarships are designed to assist recent high school graduates entering their first-year of an undergraduate or vocational program. Students must be graduates of a high school in the U.S. Virgin Islands or be a high school graduate and child of a member of the Virgin Islands Association, DC. Three (3) awards in the amount of \$1,000 each will be awarded in 2017.

Eligibility Requirements

- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of **3.0** on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a graduate of a high school in the U.S. Virgin Islands (St. Thomas, St. Croix or St. John) **OR** be a child of a VIA-DC member.
- Have plans to **enroll FULL-TIME in an undergraduate program or a vocational program** during the 2017-2018 academic year.

Required Documents

- Completed application must be accessed online at: <http://www.viadc.org/>. The following application additions must be provided through viascholarships2017@gmail.com :
- Most recent **official** transcript issued from your High School. Copies or Web printouts are not accepted.
- Two letters of recommendation (teacher, advisor, employer/supervisor, counselor or other individual who can speak to your character, learning proficiency, values and goals) submitted in a sealed envelope with recommenders initials signed across the seal. Recommendations from family members are not permitted.
- One page (sized 8 ½ x 11, single space, one side only) typed essay highlighting academic and career goals and addressing the topic of how your education (supported by this scholarship) will influence the Virgin Islands.
- Proof of acceptance from an institution of learning for the 2017-2018 academic year.
- Copy of SAT or other standardized scores (not required for applicants to vocational programs).

Scholarship Tips for Applicants

1. Carefully review the scholarship requirements and complete all application instructions.
2. Ask a colleague to proofread your documents prior to submission.
3. Arrange to have your high school transcript and two confidential letters of recommendation forwarded to the Scholarship Selection Committee at viascholarships2017@gmail.com.
4. Compose your essay on a separate page. Include work experience, leadership experience, community activities, honors and awards, academic goals and career goals (as applicable) as you respond to **why** it is important for you to receive this scholarship. Submit to viascholarships2017@gmail.com, Include your name in subject line.
5. Include a copy of your acceptance letter to a college or university for the 2017-2018 academic year.
6. Certify (by signature) that all information provided on the application is true to the best of your knowledge.

Scholarship Tips for Recommendation Letter Writers

1. Your letter of recommendation must be submitted by email, no later than May 1, 2017.
2. Verify and speak to your relationship to the applicant for whom you are writing the letter of recommendation
3. Submit your letter from your email account
4. In the Subject Line of your email, please reference the name of the student for whom you are supporting.
